

# DUI Detection and Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST) Basic Course

During this 24-hour course, law enforcement officers will learn:

- How to recognize behavior that points towards impaired driving;
- The importance of the SFST battery, and how to properly administer the tests;
- When to make an impaired driving arrest;
- How to write accurate and detailed reports;
- How to give clear and convincing testimony.

Further, officers will receive instruction on how to conduct thorough impaired driving investigations, understand the scientifically tested methods to detect, screen, and process impaired drivers.

**Prerequisite:** Students should be a state certified or commissioned law enforcement officer in a full time paid capacity. To attend, officers must possess a valid Washington State breath test instrument operator permit.
