<b>General:</b>	Classroom and gym drills will be conducted. Waiver forms will be provided at the beginning of class.
<b>Equipment &amp; Attire:</b>	Required: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Duty belt with belt keepers</li><li>• Gun holster</li><li>• Taser holster</li><li>• Note-taking materials</li></ul> Optional: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mock firearm only if carry something other than Glock.</li><li>• Mat shoes</li><li>• Knee pads</li><li>• Mouth piece</li><li>• Light duty gloves</li></ul>
<b>Note-Taking</b>	Note-taking items such as notebook paper, pens, and pencils, will <b>not</b> be made available at the training site, and are the responsibility of each attendee.
<b>Smoking / Alcohol:</b>	Alcohol and controlled substances are not permitted anywhere within Commission dormitories or on Commission premises. Smoking is permitted outside Commission in designated areas. Participants are required to use the available ash can to extinguish and dispose of cigarettes. Smokeless tobacco is also prohibited.
