Course Instructors: This course is presented by Wacveo and instructors from the USDOT Drug Interdiction Assistance Program. It will be our pleasure to present two guest Instructors from the State of Kentucky.

Course Information: This 40 hour course was designed to equip Law Enforcement personnel and specifically commercial vehicle inspection personnel with the tools to identify and apprehend transporters and users of illicit drugs. This course was also designed to support and enhance Local, State and Federal drug enforcement and interdiction initiatives. This course will further assist in the removal of impaired and unqualified drivers of commercial motor vehicles, which will result in improved highway safety and reduced commercial vehicle crashes.

Purpose: To familiarize Commercial Vehicle Inspection Personnel and Drug K-9 Handlers with:

- Current drug trafficking trends and smuggling patterns
- Commercial Vehicle driver interview techniques
- Commercial vehicle rapid assessment / criminal interdiction techniques
- Commercial vehicle search techniques
- Search and seizure law applicable to roadside encounters
- Bulk drug movement indicators and detection methods
- Indicators of a driver using, possessing, selling, or hauling illicit drugs
- Commercial Vehicle Concealment techniques
- Characteristics of impaired drivers
- Use of the El Paso Intelligence Center ~ EPIC

Course Attendants: The course is specifically offered to Commercial Vehicle Inspection Personnel and Certified Drug K-9 Handlers. The course is divided into two major components.

Component 1 – Twenty-four hours of classroom instruction presented by members of the USDOT Drug Interdiction Assistance Program.

Component 2 – Sixteen hours of practical (hands-on) training working along side US Border Patrol, US Customs and State Patrol Personnel at the Port of Entry, Blaine, Washington

Due to the possibility of actual apprehension and / or seizures, the US Border Patrol will be requesting that K-9 officers present copies of their K-9's Certifications. Further information will be offered at time of registration
