Course Information:

This course is designed to develop coordination, balance, control, and the confidence necessary for proficient operation of the police motorcycle, and to familiarize participants with the handling characteristics of their police motorcycle.

Equipment Required:

- Police Motorcycle – properly maintained, including good brakes, tires and clutch
- Duty belt (complete with gun and flashlight and radio)
- Department duty or training uniform, ¾ or full face helmet, ankle support boots
- Clear eye protection, gloves, ballistic vest, rain gear

Lodging:

All lodging reservations and arraignments are the responsibility of each student.

Cost:

Class Tuition: Free

Motorcycle Maintenance or Repair Costs: Students should make prior arraignments with local dealers to address any motorcycle maintenance or repair issues needed during the school.

Pre-Ride Training: It is recommended that students receive some pre-ride training from a qualified Motors Instructor prior to the class. SCSO will be conducting this training March 9-10. Registered students may also attend any portion of this training at no cost if they like.
