**Student Instructions**

<b>Dates:</b>	<b>August 1-4, 2016</b>
<b>Location:</b>	Tacoma Police Firing Range 101 McMurray Road NE Tacoma, WA
<b>Class Hours:</b>	Participants are to arrive by <b>7:45 AM</b> on August 1, 2016. Class hours are 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM daily.
<b>Fee:</b>	<b>\$650.</b> All students will be invoiced upon course completion.
<b>Prerequisite:</b>	Current Private Security Certified Firearms Instructor or Law Enforcement Firearms Instructor status through WSCJTC. All students will sign a liability release form at check-in for the course.
<b>Prequalification:</b>	<b>~ No prequalification test is required or given for this class.</b>
<b>Travel/Meals &amp; Lodging:</b>	Travel and meals will be the responsibility of the participant or his or her agency. There will be no reimbursement for expenses.
<b>Attire:</b>	Suitable clothing for range during fair or inclement weather. Boots are recommended. Field dress and rain gear will be necessary for outside training which begins on the first day of class.
<b>Note-Taking</b>	Note-taking items such as laptop, notebook paper, pens, and pencils, will <b>not</b> be made available at the training site, and are the responsibility of each attendee.
<b>Smoking / Alcohol:</b>	Alcohol, controlled substances, and smokeless tobacco are not permitted. Smoking is permitted in designated areas. Participants are required to use the available ash can to extinguish and dispose of cigarettes.

<b>Ammo:</b>	The following ammunition is <b>REQUIRED</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 500 rounds match grade ammunition</li></ul>
<b>Equipment Needs:</b>	The following equipment is <b>REQUIRED for EACH student</b> : <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Scoped bolt action or semi-automatic rifle capable of one Minute of Angle Accuracy out to 300 yards.</li><li>2. Spare rifle magazine carrier (either belt or weapon mounted).</li><li>3. Rifle sling.</li><li>4. Minimum of two rifle magazines.</li><li>5. Bipod or Rucksack to shoot off of.</li><li>6. All weather clothing.</li></ol>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>7. Eye protection (<u>including</u> clear glasses for night firing).</li> <li>8. Hearing protection – electronic headphones and earplugs.</li> <li>9. Weapon cleaning equipment.</li> <li>10. Basic repair tools specific to your rifle.</li> <li>11. BDU type pants with cargo pockets.</li> <li>12. Notetaking materials with writing utensils.</li> <li>13. Baseball cap.</li> <li>14. Body armor.</li> </ol>
<b>Documents:</b>	<p>The following documents are <b>REQUIRED</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Manufacturer’s operator manual for rifle</li> <li>• Manufacturer’s operator manual for optic</li> </ul>
<b>Optional:</b>	<p>The following equipment is <b>recommended</b>:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Spotting scope</li> <li>2. Shooting pad</li> <li>3. Rain poncho/parka</li> <li>4. Water bottle</li> <li>5. Knee pads</li> <li>6. Elbow pads</li> <li>7. Laptop computer</li> </ol>
<b>Required Course Work:</b>	<p>To successfully complete the course the student will need to pass a written exam covering the operation/deployment of the weapon system as well as a final shooting skills test. Both require 80% plus to pass. There will be two opportunities to pass the final shooting course of fire. Absenteeism is not acceptable in this course. Notify the Commission immediately if you are unable to attend the course.</p>
<b>Attendance:</b>	<p>Certificates of completion will be awarded to those attendees who successfully complete the course in its entirety. Instructors must pre-approve any time out of class.</p>
