Materials:	<p>Note-taking items such as notebook paper, pens, and pencils, will <u>not</u> be made available at the training site, and are the responsibility of each attendee.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• DSLR camera (camera that allows you to change lenses)• General purpose lens (usually 18mm to 120mm somewhere in that range)• Macro/Micro lens (lens needs to be capable of shooting 1:1, or macro filter kits will also work)• External Flash (flash needs to be capable of shooting in Auto and Manual mode)• Lateral Tripod (regular plastic tripods will not work, the tripod needs to be fully adjustable and recommend a pistol grip head)• Remote shutter release (wireless or cord)• Off camera flash cord (even if flash is wireless should at least 3' long)• Camera Manual (if you don't have one then download one PRIOR to class)• Video cord for camera (cord usually has one yellow end and came with camera)• Large black umbrella• "L" shaped ABFO ruler and/or Hinged L reference scale (one side black or gray other side white)• Small pushbutton flashlight• 2 – Camera cards (should be at least 4GB each)• Extra Flash batteries
