Advanced Motor Officer Certification

Course Date: July 21st & 22nd, 2016

Course Time: 0800 – 1600 hours (16 Hours Total)

Location: WSP Academy, Shelton, WA

Course Information:

This course is designed to develop Advanced Police Motor Officer riding skills and to familiarize participants with the handling characteristics of their police motorcycle at higher speeds on a closed course environment. Training will include exercises intended to improve cornering set-up, counter steering and cornering, speed control and braking, and handling the motorcycle during rapid acceleration and deceleration combined with precision pattern negotiation.

Equipment Required:

- Police Motorcycle – properly maintained w/ **Good Tires**.
- Department Motorcycle duty or training uniform, ¾ or full face helmet, ankle supporting boots
- Eye protection, gloves, ballistic vest, rain gear

Lodging:

All lodging, reservations, and arrangements are the responsibility of each attendee. The primary lodging option for most agencies is the Little Creek Hotel, Shelton WA (early reservation recommended). However, other possible options include the WSP Shelton Academy (subject to availability) and there are other motel options in Shelton.

Schedule & Training plan

This motor training will be conducted at the WSP Academy, Shelton, WA on July 21st and 22nd, 2016. The Bellevue Police Department's Motor Unit will be the host this year and will coordinate the training. The specific schedule for each day of training is TBD.

However, the group will be divided into training groups. Respectively the groups will rotate between the back track, front track, and infield. Each group will have approximately four hours per section on the track over the two days of training. Each group will have an assigned group of instructors and a lead instructor.

Training will include:

Back track - may include the following training:

- Back track run counterclockwise
- Back track run clockwise
- Off road
- High Speed braking

- Braking in a curve
- Negotiating a curve
- Braking on downhill grass

Front track - may include the violator apprehension course and the obstacle course.

Infield - may include the following training:

- Patterns
- 140 pullout
- Pair braking
- 30,40,50 MPH braking
- Braking on gravel
- Braking on grass
- Excel U-Turns

Cost:

Tuition: \$55.00 per attendee – track fee. Make checks payable to City of Bellevue. Payment must be received at the time of registration.
