The Crime Free Multi-Housing Program is designed as a partnership between law enforcement and rental property owners, managers, and tenants to keep drugs and illegal activity out of rental property. When crime and drugs operate out of rental property, neighborhoods suffer and landlords pay a high price. The program uses a unique three-part approach to maintain crime prevention goals:

- ❶ Property Owner/Manager Training
- ❷ Physical Crime Prevention Survey of Premises
- ❸ Annual Tenant Personal Safety & Crime Prevention
