Course Description: NAEMT's Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) program is based on the guidelines from the Committee on Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (Co-TECC) and the Tactical Combat Casualty Care (TCCC) program. TECC uses lessons learned from our military and applies them to the civilian world of tactical medicine.

What sets this course apart is its extensive use of simulation. Participants will don body armor, helmets and will work in realistic, stressful conditions.
