Student Instructions

Attendees are requested to report on **Monday, June 13, 2011**, at **7:45 AM** to the Spokane Police Training Center located at 2302 North Waterworks, Spokane, WA 99212. Class times will be from 8 AM -5 PM daily.

Lodging, Travel, and Meals: Travel and meals will be the responsibility of the participant or his or her agency. **There will be no reimbursement for expenses.**

Costs: **\$750.** Non cancelled no-shows will be charged the course fee. Agencies will be billed upon completion of the course.

Cancellation Guidelines: In order to avoid being charged the full course fee, applications must be canceled via email blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us no later than **June 6, 2011**. No exceptions will be made.

Entry/Prerequisite Qualification: All students must score a minimum of 85% on the entry shooting skills test. This requirement allows the course to be delivered at an instructor level. Therefore, we offer three options:

Option 1 (SPOKANE)

The student attends the prequalification scheduled for **10 AM on Tuesday, May 24, 2011** at the Spokane Police Department Range located at 2302 Waterworks, Spokane WA 99212 **If the student does not meet the minimum score, the student will not attend the course and the agency will not be billed the \$750 course fee.** If the student chooses option 1, please RSVP via email at blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us no later than March 7th, 2011.

Option 2 (BURIEN)

The student attends the prequalification scheduled for **10 AM on Tuesday May 24, 2011**, at the WSCJTC Firing Range, 19010 1st Ave South, Burien WA 98148. **If the student does not meet the minimum score, the student will not attend the course and the agency will not be billed the \$750 course fee.** If the student chooses option 2, please RSVP via email at blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us no later than March 7th, 2011.

Option 3: (BURIEN)

The student prequalifies at **7 AM** on the **first day of class**. Students that do not pass the entry qualification on the first day of the class will be removed from that class and their agency will be billed for the full class tuition fee.

Attire: Appropriate dress for both classroom and outdoor environment.

Attendance: Certificates of completion will be awarded to those attendees who successfully complete the course in its entirety. **This is an instructor course and absences will not be excused. Please cancel your position in the class if you anticipate missing any part of the school.**

Course Format: Classroom lecture, demonstrations and practical dry and live fire range exercises.

Course Format for Night Shoot: There may be one evening session required for night shooting. You will receive the schedule on the first day of class.

Documents: The following document is **REQUIRED:**

- ☞ Copy of agency's firearms policies

Course Work Requirement: This is a pass/fail course and will require you to attend the entire course. You will be required to:

- ☞ Do homework,
- ☞ Prepare a minimum of two lesson plans,
- ☞ Teach a minimum of two classes,
- ☞ Pass two written exams,
- ☞ Pass timed weapon manipulation drills,
- ☞ Demonstrate safety with all of your firearms at all times,
- ☞ Shoot passing scores on the various courses of fire.

You will not receive a certificate if you fail any one of the above requirements. **This is an instructor course and absences will not be excused.** Please cancel your position in the class if you anticipate missing any part of the course.

Certificates of completion will be awarded to those participants who successfully complete the course in its entirety.

Participants are advised that extensive course work and reading after class is necessary. We recommend long commutes or night shift work be avoided during the course.

Ammo: The following ammunition is **REQUIRED:**

- ☞ 1000 rounds primary handgun
- ☞ 50 rounds frangible
- ☞ A minimum of 20 dummy rounds for your duty pistol
- ☞ Spare pistol

- Equipment Needs:** The following equipment is **REQUIRED:**
- ☞ Duty handgun and patrol duty belt. No thigh holsters.
 - ☞ A minimum of three extra magazines.
 - ☞ Inert Training Pistol (dummy; red or blue).
 - ☞ Double-Action Revolver holster.
 - ☞ Duty flashlight.
 - ☞ Eye protection (including clear glasses for night firing)
 - ☞ Hearing protection-electronic headphones and earplugs
 - ☞ Copy of your agency's firearms policies
 - ☞ Weapon cleaning equipment
 - ☞ BDU type pants with cargo pockets
 - ☞ Clipboard & note taking material.
 - ☞ Whistle.
 - ☞ Stopwatch or watch with second hand.
 - ☞ Baseball cap.
 - ☞ Body armor.

- Optional:** The following equipment is **RECOMMENDED:**
- ☞ Knee pads
 - ☞ Elbow pads
 - ☞ Laptop

Liability Release: All participants, as a condition of course attendance and participation, will be required to sign a liability release. If the participant does not bring the form with thme, additional forms will be available on the first day at the beginning of class.
