Course Description:

This 40-hour class entails in-classroom instruction on Use of Force, Federal Case Law, concepts of motor learning, Reality Based Training, and both of their uses in teaching principles in regards to control and defensive tactics. Level 1 control holds (joint manipulation, counter joint, hair takedown etc.), Level 2 (strikes, kicks, punches), vascular neck restraint, impact weapon, OC, handcuffing, ground survival and weapon retention will be taught for familiarization and instructor based fundamentals as a secondary instructor in a DT program. At the end of the 40-hour class, the student will receive a certificate of completion.

Course materials needed:

DT clothing along with duty gear including belt, impact weapon, training pistol, if available, and duty ballistic vest.
