

Child Interview Refresher Course

This day-long training is a "refresher" class for WA State law enforcement, CPS, prosecutors and child interviewers who have previously attended the 3 - 5 day "Child Abuse Interviewing and Assessment" or "Child Abuse Investigation and Interviewing" courses (CJTC course # 5357) sponsored by the WA State Criminal Justice Training Commission (CJTC), DSHS and the Alliance for Child Welfare Excellence.

The class will be taught by CJTC Child Abuse Program Manager Patti Toth. It will review and reinforce research-based best practices in child forensic interviewing and discuss recent modifications to best practices in child forensic interviewing. Specific topics will include:

- Changes in recommendations regarding truth-lie discussions
- Current best practice re: Interview instructions (or 'ground rules')
- Current best practice re: "Narrative event practice"

Note: This is a follow-up class to CJTC course #5357 and does not fully satisfy the RCW 43.101.234 and RCW 74.14B.010 requirements for specialized child interview training for those who investigate child sexual abuse cases.
