



## ***Law Enforcement Agencies...***

The Crime Scene Evidence Technician Course is a two-week course designed for the police officer involved in any aspect of law enforcement, particularly patrol, traffic/collision investigations, burglary and other property crime investigations as well as other non-violent offenses where crime scene processing and evidence collection may occur. This course will prepare and enable the student to correctly document a crime scene, take quality crime scene photographs and quality evidence photographs, collect and preserve evidence, and provide context for many types of evidence and how to find and recognize important physical evidence. The course will be a combination of class room, laboratory hands-on-exercises, and simulated crime scenes to give the students a comprehensive learning experience. This course is taught by Washington State Patrol Crime Laboratory Division personnel, recognized experts in their respective forensic fields.
