The instructor skillfully uses imagery with anecdotal accounts of the historical past with our present, while utilizing the worldwide internet, videos and case samples, including crime scene photos that depict diverse features of sexual deviant behavior. Psychosocial histories and backgrounds of perpetrators will be presented and analyzed.
