Yes, the team relay is back. It is time for people to avenge our last gathering in Chelan in 2012 for the “Yellow Brick Road – Red Apple – City of Chelan – Fun Run”. The relay will take place on Wednesday, September 7th - 3:30 PM outside Campbell’s Lobby. This year relay teams will consist of three members with each team having at least 2 of the 3 members being NA grads. As usual bragging rights are on the line!

Leg One – Fun Run

Runners will start at Campbell’s Resort and run approximately 1 mile around the east end of the lake. Each runner will be carrying the team’s Frisbee that will be used to complete the third leg of the course.

Leg Two – Watercraft Paddle

Runners will hand off their Frisbee to their second team member who will be waiting near the water’s edge to set sail in one of two watercrafts – kayak or paddle board. There will be a limited number of each watercraft so the faster your team’s runner is the better your chances are to obtain the watercraft of your choice. The paddlers will paddle west under the bridge up the channel between Campbell’s and Caravel to the beach in front of the hospitality room where throngs of NA grads will be waiting with a cold one to cheer teams on to the next leg.

Leg Three – Frisbee Toss

For the third and final leg paddlers will hand off their team Frisbee to their third team member who will complete the Frisbee toss. There will be multiple hoops throughout the lawn area that the team member will have to successfully toss their Frisbee through. Once this is completed the team member must return to the finish line near the beach outside the hospitality room with their team Frisbee. So gather your best runner, paddler, and tosser and sign up early - the competition will be fierce. If you would like to participate and do not have a team send your info to me and I will see what I can do to put together a pick-up team so everyone can play. All participants will receive a special yellow brick this year.
