



# BUILDING ENTRY TRAINING FOR NARCOTICS DETECTIVES

## Course Description:

This is a 40 hour course focusing on the basic techniques of building entries, immediate action drills, care under fire, and use of force issues.

This course is designed for drug units of all sizes, gang units, and small pro-act teams that frequently conduct operations involving the service of search warrants and vehicle take-downs.

This course is designed for all skill levels. New and experienced officers and detectives are encouraged to attend.

The training will consist of minimal classroom time. The majority of the time will spent in practical application.

- Immediate Action Drills
- Breaching
- Care Under Fire
- Live Fire Shoot House/Range
- Use of Ballistic Shield
- Vehicle Take-downs
- UC/CS Rescue
