The class is two full days and taught by [Dr. Brandy Fay](#) (DVM), who owns the [Chehalis Centralia Veterinary Hospital](#) and has taught this class multiple times before for the WSPCA and their members. Day one will consist of standard K9 First Aid and CPR and day two will consist of a more detailed look at K9 trauma (gunshots, stab wounds, heat exhaustion, etc.). Parts of this class will be very hands on, so bringing your K9 Partner is preferred.
