- ARRIVAL:** Participants will report on **Monday May 16** to the King County Sheriff's Range, 26520 292nd Ave SE, Ravensdale WA at **08:00am**. Class hours are 0800-1700 daily.
- COST** There is a \$500 administrative cost to attendees to be paid to CJTC. Agencies will be invoiced; **DO NOT** bring checks or vouchers to the class.
- TRAVEL/MEALS** Travel, meals and lodging will be the responsibility of the attendee or his/her
- LODGING:** department. Restaurants are locally available.
- ATTIRE** **See equipment list.**
- PREREQUISITES:** Participants must have successfully completed the Sniper Basic class (0531) or have prior permission.
- EQUIPMENT** Please bring the following items with you to class:
- NEEDS**
- Mission equipment consistent with deployments as Scout /Sniper.
 - Bolt or Semi-Action Rifle - minimum 308 caliber - trigger pull of no less than 3lbs. Rifle must be capable of firing 1" groups at 100 yds.
 - Scope must have sufficient elevation "come-up" to engage 600 yard targets.
 - 300 rounds of match grade or duty rifle ammunition.
 - Handgun.
 - 100 rounds handgun ammunition.
 - 50 rounds barrier rifle ammunition (optional)
 - Appropriate camouflage clothing & equipment for mission deployment exercises in both open country and urban environments.
 - Clothing appropriate for outdoor training.
 - APR (Gas Mask) if not part of standard mission deployment gear.
 - Lunches for all five days (Will be taking lunch in the field)
- TELEPHONE** Attendees should advise their families and departments of how to reach them at the school in the event of an emergency. Please have the caller inform the receptionist of the class you are attending when calling.
