He received decorations including the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star Medal of Valor, the Purple Heart and many more. Colonel McKnight also holds his masters degree from the University of Florida. He has also served as a Professor of Military Science. His education includes the US Army War College, Air Command and Staff College, Ranger School, Airborne School and Infantry Officer Basic School.
