PREREQUISITE:

Students who attend this class should have approx. 3-5 years-worth of experience investigating collisions. Students also need to have completed the Advanced Collision Investigation course or its equivalent. Exceptions can be granted on a case-by-case basis with the lead instructor.

Students need to bring the following supplies/items to class:

Mechanical (drafting) pencils, highlighter, clipboard, traffic template (Northwestern, IPTM, etc.), engineer's scale ruler, 360-degree protractor, two 30-60-90 degree drafting triangles, scientific calculator with trig functions, and 25', 100', 300' measuring tapes.
