In conjunction with the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC) the Washington State Patrol Impaired Driving Section is offering a Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFST) Refresher Course. This course will be required for any and all law enforcement agency whose officers are awarded any additional grant funds through the Washington Traffic Safety Commission (WTSC). The SFST Refresher course is a four hour block of class room instruction.

The SFST Refresher course is an excellent means of staying current on DUI/SFST related issues. All interested law enforcement officers should have completed the SFST Basic Course prior to attending the refresher course.

**Course requirements:** Currently employed as a career or reserve law enforcement officer and completion of the NHSTA Basic SFST 16- or 24-hour course at some point during career.
