



# DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO LACEY CITY HALL

- From the South (Portland):** Take Interstate 5 to Exit 108, follow signs to College Street. Go straight through signalized intersection at College Street and 3rd. Avenue. This takes you directly into the Lacey City Hall parking lot. Please note designated Community Room parking area on map.
- From the North (Seattle):** Take Interstate 5 to Exit 109 to Martin Way. At the bottom of exit ramp turn right at the signalized intersection onto Martin Way. Move into left-turn lane and turn left onto College Street. Go over bridge to first signalized intersection at 3rd. Avenue and College Street. Turn left onto 3rd. Avenue. This takes you directly into the Lacey City Hall parking lot. Please note designated Community Room parking area on map.
