Participants are requested to report on **MONDAY September 19, 2011**, to the King County Sheriff's Range, 26520 292nd Ave. SE, Ravensdale WA at 8:00am. Class hours are 0800-1800 each day.

- Lodging, Travel, and Meals:** Travel and meals will be the responsibility of the participant or his or her agency. Restaurants are locally available for breakfast and dinner, lunch and refreshments must be brought with the student to the ranges
There will be no reimbursement for expenses.
- Costs:** **\$300.** Non cancelled no-shows will be charged the course fee. Agencies will be billed upon completion of the course.
- Cancellation Guidelines:** In order to avoid being charged the full course fee, applications must be canceled via email blearegistrar@cjtc.state.wa.us no later than **September 12, 2011**. No exceptions will be made.
- Attire:** Appropriate dress for both classroom and outdoor environment.

- Attendance:** 100% attendance is required. The student will be required to pass a written test with a minimum score of 80%, and a shooting qualification course with a minimum score of 80%. Certificates of completion will be awarded to those attendees who successfully complete the course in its entirety.
- Equipment Needs:** The following equipment is **REQUIRED:**
- ☞ Bolt or semi-auto service rifle. .223, 308, 30-06 calibers.
 - Other Calibers by permission - Contact Sgt Cecil 206-835-7373.
 - ☞ Variable power telescopic sight.
 - ☞ 500 rounds of match grade or duty ammunition - no reloads.
 - ☞ Bi-Pod & Sling.
 - ☞ Rear Bag or Rest for supporting rifle.
 - ☞ Eye and Hearing Protection.
 - ☞ Rifle Cleaning equipment.
 - ☞ Shooting Pad or Ground Cover
 - ☞ Material to record notes and Data in the field.
 - ☞ Students should bring a lunch and refreshments with them each day.
