

Sergeant Bill Long's Biography

Sergeant Bill Long has been with the Phoenix Police Department for over 20 years. Bill Long began his career as a patrol officer and later earned a position as a detective in the Gang Enforcement Unit. While in this position, Detective Long was responsible for the investigation of gang related crimes occurring in the Phoenix Metropolitan area. During this assignment Detective Long developed a knack for investigating Asian Gangs operating in the Phoenix metropolitan area.

In 1995 Detective Long was assigned to the Drug Enforcement Bureau as an undercover detective. This assignment led Detective Long to make countless undercover hand-to-hand purchases of illegal drugs and the authoring of affidavits for search warrants. While assigned in the Drug Enforcement Bureau, Detective Long also was involved in court ordered wire-tap investigations.

Detective Long later earned a spot in the Phoenix Police Departments Special Projects Unit continuing his work as an undercover detective. This Unit is unique in the fact that undercover detectives operate as "fences" that purchase stolen property from various suspects. The unit is currently one of the longest running continuous sting operations known to law enforcement, functioning since 1977. This assignment provided the opportunity for Detective Long to hone his skills at working in an undercover capacity and conduct long term covert investigations. During this assignment Detective Long had the opportunity to have involvement in hundreds of undercover transactions which included the development and implementing of storefront operations.

Detective Long was later offered a position in the Organized Crime Bureau wherein his focus was the investigation of various Organized Crime Groups, specifically Asian Criminal Enterprises. During this assignment Detective Long was the case agent on several major complex investigations which included the use of court ordered wire taps to target these Organized Crime Groups.

Because of Detective Long's experience and training in long-term undercover investigations, he was assigned to work with the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms on a case which ultimately became known Operation Black Biscuit. This undercover investigation resulted in Detective Long, along with his ATF counterpart, becoming members of the Hells Angels. Operation Black Biscuit spanned almost 2 years with travel throughout many locations in the western United States.

Upon completion of Operation Black Biscuit, Detective Long was sent to study Vietnamese language and culture at a military base known as the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center (DLI) in Monterey, California. Detective Long lived in Monterey, California and studied at this school for a period of 15 months. Since graduating from DLI, Detective Long has continued his studies at Arizona State University. In 2005 Detective Long also was granted a scholarship to travel to Vietnam and study Vietnamese Culture and language. Detective Long has been certified by the Defense Language Institute Foreign Language Center as a Vietnamese Linguist.

In 2007, Detective Long was promoted to Sergeant and assigned worked in Patrol. Sergeant Long gained a position in the Major Offender Bureau, Career Criminal Squad in 2008. It was during this assignment that Sergeant Long managed both complex and undercover operations involving repeat offenders and prison gang members.

In 2009 Sergeant Long was assigned to the Phoenix Police Departments Homicide Unit where he manages a Homicide Response Squad.
