DESCRIPTION:

COURSE PREREQUISITES: The successful completion (80% minimum) of the test for the Washington State *Adventures in Boating* course and PRIOR to the start of class. Officers are required to bring a personal watercraft (PWC), Type III lifejacket, drysuit or wetsuit, and eye protection.

DETAILS: This course is 8 hours and will teach officers about vessel propulsion systems, vessel handling characteristics, routine maintenance, and the operation of personal watercraft for use during law enforcement contacts in flat-water conditions. Course details will also be posted on the CJTC website and announcements will be sent out to all approved program supervisors/lead officers. Class size is limited to 16 officers. There is no course fee.

This course is designed for commissioned full-time and reserve officers assigned to boating safety programs.
