### **Course Description:**

This is a 4-hour in-service training course intended as a review of the use deadly force by law enforcement officers. During this course participants will examine Federal and Washington State Laws specific to the use of deadly force. Students will review videos and scenarios then determine if actions are supported by law and department policy. At conclusion of this course the student should;

1. Present clear explanation of pertinent legal definitions.
2. Present clear explanation of Federal law as it pertains to use of deadly force by LEOs.
3. Present clear explanation of WA State law as it pertains to the use of deadly force by LEOs.
4. Present clear explanation of department policy's relationship to the law.
5. Present an easily remembered method of making rapid legal-based decisions on whether a use of deadly force is legal or not.
