Course Description

This course certifies attendees as PepperBall Instructors for their individual agency, allowing the attendee to design a course in the safe and effective use of the PepperBall System. The armorer course certifies students as armorers on the Custom Carbine SX launcher. For certification on the SA200 launchers, students must bring their own launcher to the class.
