**Frank Campbell** is retired as a deputy and canine trainer for the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office in Florida. Mr. Campbell served with the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office since 1978. His assignments have included patrol, explosives, narcotics canine handler and trainer, FTO, and special weapons and tactics team member. He has also trained with the Royal Dutch Air Force and French National Police in narcotic detection. Mr. Campbell has also served in the United States Army. Mr. Campbell is a Florida certified evaluator and instructor for police canines. He is also a USPCA Level I trainer, NRA Firearms instructor and S&W Chemical Agent instructor.

This course is being offered by Multijurisdictional Counter Drug Task Force Training as part of the Washington State Police Canine Association spring training seminar. It is intended for drug dog handlers. The format of the class will be classroom instruction, so handlers do not need to bring their canine partners.
