



Law Enforcement Alerting Portal Training Announcement

The AMBER Alert Program is a voluntary partnership between law enforcement agencies, broadcasters, transportation agencies, and the wireless industry, to activate an urgent bulletin in the most serious child-abduction cases and to instantly galvanize the community to assist in the safe recovery of the child. The AMBER Alert Program is coordinated nationally by the U.S. Department of Justice.

The Washington State Patrol will be presenting refresher classes on the use of the AMBER Alert Law Enforcement Alerting Portal (LEAP™) to provide activating agency users with the technical training to access the web portal and enter, update, and cancel alerts.

Topics included: AMBER Alert Plan and Criteria, Introduction to LEAP 2.0, Roles of Users, Managing Users, Create, Update, and Cancel Alerts, and how AMBER Alerts are distributed.

Introduction to LEAP's role in the Endangered Missing Persons Advisory

Audience: Law enforcement officers and detectives, dispatchers, and records personnel that will be doing actual entries, updates, and cancellations of AMBER alerts and/or Endangered Missing Persons Alerts.
