Dr. Daniel W. Clark Ph.D. is a licensed clinical psychologist currently working as the Washington State Patrol Department Psychologist. He provides clinical services to WSP employees and their family members, teaches at the WSP Academy, provides psychological screening of trooper applicants, and consults with command staff on Agency issues. He is a faculty member of the International Critical Incidents Stress Foundation and a recognized CISM: Group Intervention, CISM: Advanced Group Crisis Intervention, CISM: Individual Crisis Intervention and Peer Support, and Law Enforcement Perspectives for CISM Enhancement Instructor. In 1998, he developed his Suicide Prevention, Intervention, and Postvention course, which he presents with the ICISF around the country. He co-wrote the Strategic Response to Crisis curriculum for ICISF. He is a past-President of the Washington Critical Incident Stress Management Network, which provides training and service in managing critical incidents.
