## STUDENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Arrival:** Monday, June 6, 2011 to North Precinct-Snohomish County SO, 15100 40<sup>th</sup> Ave, Marysville, WA 98271.
- Class Hours:** Monday- Friday, 0800-1700
- Costs:** \$50, per attendee. Agencies will be invoiced.
- Travel/Meals & Lodging:** Meal and Lodging are the responsibility of your agency.
- Attire:** Business Casual attire is appropriate for classroom wear. *Please no jeans, t-shirts, shorts, sweatshirts, or tennis shoes.*
- Telephone:** You should advise your family and agency of how to reach you at the training facility in the event of an emergency. Please have caller identify the class, **by name**, that you are attending. They will **not** take personal messages of a non-emergent nature.

- Note-Taking:** Note-taking items such as notebook paper, pens, and pencils, will **not** be made available at the training site, and are the responsibility of each attendee.
- Equipment:** 100 & 300 ft tape measure, outdoor clothing, colored and mechanical pencils.
