


NORMANDY PARK POLICE

Applicants must answer **YES** to one of the following:

Graduated from a CJTC approved LE Academy, with a minimum of 24 months of continuous service as a full-time commissioned Officer within the last 36 months.

Served as a Military Police Officer for a minimum of 24 months and have graduated from a Civil Service approved MP Academy.

Graduated from the Basic Law Enforcement Academy or CJTC approved Reserve Police Training Academy.

Successfully completed, from an accredited college or university, a minimum of one year of study with 50% LE courses, or two years of college study, 90 quarter hours or 60 semester hours.

The mission of the Normandy Park Police Department is to coordinate and lead the efforts in our community to preserve the public peace and protect the rights of persons. We pledge to provide assistance to citizens and visitors in urgent situations, and to be diligent in our efforts to detect and prevent crime.

The Normandy Park Police Department serves approximately 6,500 citizens over about 2.5 square miles in southwest King County in the State of Washington. 10 commissioned police officers (which include 1 Chief of Police, 2 Sergeants, 1 Detective and 6 patrol officers), 1 community service officer, 4 reserve police officers, 1 volunteer position and 2 non-commissioned staff are dedicated to providing community service oriented policing to the citizens, business owners and visitors to the City of Normandy Park.

Normandy Park Police Officers are highly trained, self-motivated individuals making a difference in the City. Officers are encouraged to find innovative ways to improve the way policing is conducted in the City of Normandy Park. Many Officers receive over 100 hours of training per year. There are many specialty units in the Department, to include the Coalition of Small Police Agencies Special Operations Team and Major Crimes Task Force, Motorcycle, K9 and bicycle patrol.
