The Washington State Attorney General's Office Civil Rights Unit in Seattle is seeking candidates for a full-time AGO Senior Investigator/Analyst. This position is located in downtown Seattle. The incumbent in this position will be required to fluently read, write, and speak in English and Spanish languages and have the ability to effectively, efficiently and accurately translate from English to Spanish and Spanish to English.

The Civil Rights Unit investigates and litigates violations of the laws of Washington State that may include discrimination on the basis of race, gender, sexual orientation, religion, disability, and veteran status. The Civil Rights Unit will work closely with the Consumer Protection Division and the Criminal Justice Division of the AG's Office, as well as with the Washington Human Rights Commission and federal agencies.
