

Entry Level/Lateral Entry Police Officer

The City of College Place is accepting applications to form an eligibility list for entry level/lateral entry Police Officers. Applicants must be a citizen of the United States, be a minimum of twenty-one years of age, and have graduated from high school or obtained a GED. A degree in Criminal Justice is preferred. Lateral entry candidates must be employed as a commissioned full-time, general authority law enforcement officer for a minimum of two years by the closing date for the examination. If not presently employed with an accredited police agency for two or more years, lateral entry candidates must be eligible to challenge and complete a course of study designed by the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission. Salary for entry level officers without State certification is \$3,838. Salary range for lateral entry officers is between \$4,470 to \$5,031 DOE. A hiring bonus may be offered to lateral entry candidates pending successful completion of pre-employment testing. A complete job description is available at www.ci.college-place.wa.us.
