The City of Chehalis is accepting applications for Lateral Police Officers to fill one immediate opening and other anticipated openings. **CLOSING DATE:** 12/31/2020. **SALARY RANGE:** \$4,727 to \$5,722 per month. **SUMMARY OF DUTIES:** As first responders, Police Officers are vital to public safety and perform basic police services in accordance with the mission, goals and objectives of the Chehalis Police Department and in compliance with governing federal, state, and local laws. **MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:** Age 21 at time of appointment; United States citizen; Read, write and speak the English language as required by RCW 41.14.100; High School graduate or equivalent; Ability to obtain a Washington State Driver's License free of suspensions or revocations; No felony convictions or series of offenses of a minor nature which would lend themselves to establish a pattern of criminal behavior, nor any criminal instances concerning moral turpitude; Ability to pass a background investigation, a medical and psychological examination, and polygraph. Lateral applicants must also have a current Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission Basic Law Enforcement Academy Certificate or equivalent certification from another state-approved academy with an understanding they must achieve certification by the Washington State Equivalency Academy within one year of employment.
