Position Summary:

Oregon Health and Science University is seeking a Training Lieutenant responsible for researching, developing, scheduling and presenting the Department's mandated training and ensuring compliance with training standards for all department members. Reporting to the Director of Public Safety, the Training Lieutenant coordinates the Department's entire training regimen, which utilizes best practices in mental health interactions, crisis intervention, de-escalation and communication. The Training Lieutenant must have excellent oral and written communication skills and be able to present effectively to all levels of the university and external audiences.

The Training Lieutenant is a commissioned position that will maintain membership in relevant professional associations dedicated to the advancement of safety and security and maintain firearms trainer certifications and active shooter intervention training. The Training Lieutenant may also be responsible for facility security, problem solving, emergency preparedness, threat assessment, representing the Director to the internal and external OHSU community, conducting relevant crime analysis, and producing reports. The Training Lieutenant will ensure the Department is responsive to the community's needs and that operations are in line with the best practices in community policing standards.

Qualifications:

Required: A Bachelor's Degree or equivalent experience in public safety leadership and at least 3 years of law enforcement training/instructor experience, law enforcement investigation experience and leadership/supervisory experience in law enforcement or related fields; police officer certification, CPR and first aid certification, a valid driver's license and the ability to pass a criminal justice background check.

Preferred: Current Armorer and instructor certifications.
