Over the past few months the Private Security Firearms Certification Program has worked with the Private Security Certified Firearms Instructors to make updates. Effective May 1, 2012, new updates are being provided for:

- Form 726 – Initial PS/PI/BBRA Firearms Certification Application
- Form 729 – Handgun Qualification Test
- Form 731 – Firearms Certification Written Test

The use of the old versions of the above listed forms will be accepted through June 30, 2012; however, the old versions will not be available for download from the WSCJTC website.

Effective July 1, 2012, only the new versions of the forms listed above will be accepted, any older version forms will be returned to agencies or individuals for correction. All other forms, not included in the update above, will be accepted using the current versions located on the WSCJTC website.
