**Overtime/Backfill Reimbursement Rates as of January 2019**

<b>Rank Description</b>	<b>Hourly Rate</b>
<b>Law enforcement – patrol officers</b>	<b>\$59/hour</b>
<b>Corrections Officers</b>	<b>\$46/hour</b>
<b>Fire – Non-paramedic</b>	<b>\$54/hour</b>
<b>Fire/EMS – Paramedic/EMT/EMS</b>	<b>\$67/hour</b>

**Overtime/Backfill Reimbursement Form Instructions**

1. Submit an application for a student to attend a CIT-King CO training class.
  - a. Classes with eligibility for overtime/backfill reimbursement are:
    - i. CIT-King CO 40-HR Basic
    - ii. CIT-King CO 8-HR In-Service
    - iii. CIT-Youth, 8-HR or TtT
    - iv. CIT-Force Options, 8-HR
    - v. CIT-Mental Health First Aid for Criminal Justice, 8-HR or TtT
    - vi. CIT-Justice Based Policing, 8-HR or TtT
    - vii. CIT-King CO Fire/EMS In-Service 8-HR or Basic\*
    - viii. CIT-King CO Corrections In-Service 8-HR or Basic\*
    - ix. CIT-King CO 911/Dispatch User Course, TTT (if applicable)
2. A notification of acceptance to training is sent via email approximately two to four weeks prior to the start of the class.
3. Upon completion of the course the agency submits an invoice with the following information:
  - a. Student(s) name(s) attending course.
  - b. Training date and location.
