**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing and Possible Permanent Adoption  
*Chapter 139-33 WAC: Firearms Certification—Bail Bond Recovery Agents*

This new chapter is being proposed to provide guidelines for individuals and companies seeking application to carry a firearm as a bail bond recovery agent, or seeking renewal of an existing firearms certification pursuant to Chapter 18.185 RCW. The Bail Bond Recovery Agent Firearms Certification is an element of a Bail Bond Recovery Agent armed license.

Public Hearing and Action by the Commission: The WSCJTC will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, December 11, 2013, at 10 AM, to discuss the proposed changes. The meeting will be held at the WSCJTC located at 19010 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South, Burien, WA, in Room E-154. All are welcome to attend and provide oral comments. Staff will request that the Commission adopt the new chapter. If adopted, the changes will be filed with the Code Reviser's Office and will become effective 31 days after filing.
