SUBJECT: Public Hearing and Possible Permanent Adoption
WAC 139-05-810: Basic training requirement for reserve officers

This rule change is being proposed to require agencies that hire a reserve officer to notify the WSCJTC of hire. The addition of this requirement will assist the WSCJTC in ensuring all reserve officers are receiving the required basic training.

Public Hearing and Action by the Commission: The WSCJTC will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 10, 2014, at 10 AM, to discuss the proposed changes. The meeting will be held at the WSCJTC located at 19010 1st Avenue South, Burien, WA, in Room E-154. All are welcome to attend and provide oral comments. Staff will request the Commission to adopt the proposed changes. If adopted, the changes will be filed with the Code Reviser's Office and will become effective 31 days after filing.
