**SUBJECT:** Public Hearing and Possible Permanent Adoption

Changes to WAC 139-10-210 have been proposed, as the language is inconsistent with that of RCW 43.101.220. RCW 43.101.220 mandates all corrections personnel to attend basic academy training; WAC 139-10-210 mandates only full-time corrections employees.

Public Hearing and Action by the Commission: The WSCJTC will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, September 11, 2013, at 10 AM, to discuss the proposed changes. The meeting will be held at the WSCJTC located at 19010 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue South, Burien, WA, in Room E-154. All are welcome to attend and provide oral comments.
