

The District's Olympus Meadows Trunk Sewer and 196th Street SE & 13th Drive SE Water Transmission Main project includes installation of water transmission main and gravity sewer with trenchless crossings under North Creek, State Route 527, and Silver Creek. The 196th Street SE water transmission main is one segment of a water transmission main that will eventually convey water from the east side of the District to the west side. The Olympus Meadows Trunk Sewer will provide capacity relief to an existing trunk sewer that has insufficient capacity.
