The Inglewood Neighborhood Drainage Project resolves existing drainage problems and supports future development without impacting natural resources or existing infrastructure. The existing infrastructure does not support the ad-hoc residential in-filling, and results in erosion of the incised channel, which has a negative impact on habitat for the Lake Sammamish Kokanee. The Kokanee were near extinct and through the efforts of the Kokanee Workgroup, are beginning to reestablish themselves. The project consists of a new collection system, trunk line conveyance and outfall to Lake Sammamish.
