An Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) system for the City of Walla Walla's water utility will include replacement of all existing residential mechanical (positive displacement) meters with solid state (magnetic flow) meters throughout the water system, obtain new large meters, install radio transmitters at all meters, and install a fixed network of data collection units to deliver all meter reading data to the City's utility billing system. The billing system modifications will include water consumption diagnostic software and a web-based customer portal to improve system maintenance and water conservation management.
