

### **Washington State Immunization Information System Update:**

A new release of the Washington State Immunization Information System (WA IIS) is moving into production this weekend. There are several updates in the Vaccine Ordering and Management module (VOMS). This document lists a summary of those changes.

#### **Online Provider Enrollment**

- Provider agreements submitted before 01/01/2014 now display the correct Frozen Vaccine Certification screen. Provider agreements submitted after 01/01/2014 will display the new Cold Storage screen.
- The Practice/Provider Profile screen now includes totals for each age group column and for each insurance type/demographic row.

#### **Reports**

- We've updated the *Washington State Vaccine Administered* report:
  - Dose Number column has been changed to Lot Number
  - All lots are included, even if no vaccine has been administered
  - Age groups for which a vaccine is not licensed are shaded grey
  - An asterisk following a lot number indicates a private lot
  - If the report cannot be displayed on a single page, the column headers are frozen

#### **Inventory Management**

- The Print button on the Reconciliation screen now works correctly. The user no longer gets stuck in a loop.

#### **Known Issues** – We expect to have fixes for these issues in early 2014

- Provider Agreements may not display correctly for some providers if the facility has been merged with another or if the Organization (IRMS) has changed.
- Providers with more than eight (8) providers listed on the Authorized Providers screen will only see the first eight providers on the printed agreement.
- Providers with more than two (2) vaccine storage units on the Cold Storage screen will only see the first two units on the 2014 printed agreement.
- The Submit Monthly Inventory button on the Reconciliation screen is not working as intended. It will save changes, but will not put a date stamp on the inventory submission. Without the date stamp, the Inventory Submission Report and the Monthly Inventory Reconciliation will not be updated correctly.
- Lot Number Summary Report: If the provider adjusts the doses administered on the Reconciliation screen, the adjusted amount will display in both the Doses Adjusted and Doses Used columns. The amount will be subtracted twice from the total.
- The yellow and red color coding on the Reconciliation screen is not displaying correctly for soon to expire and expired vaccines.
