FIXES AND NEW FEATURES

MODULE NAME	DESCRIPTION
CASA Export	Local public health users with a County-View account can now export CoCASA data for all Facilities in their County rather than just IRMS' (medical organizations) with an address in their County. This was erroneously reported to be fixed in the previous release. It now appears to be working properly.
Reports – Reports Module	The Patient Detail Report has been fixed. If you select a vaccination date range, it now displays only the vaccinations in that date range, not the entire history of vaccines.
Reports- State Reports	<p>Contraindications Report has been fixed and now works properly.</p> <p>School Certificate (CIS) – partially fixed.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The guardian name no longer appears in the demographic section of the form. This is correct and the parent/guardian is expected to complete that part of the form. • The Varicella Disease field on the CIS now appropriately checks the Yes box when a contraindication has been entered of either Parent Report of Disease or Laboratory Evidence. If a date or age has been entered in the Registry for the date of disease, that will also display on the CIS. • The remaining problem concerns the display of Tdap – this is not displaying properly and may not display at all. Will be fixed in the next release.
Vaccination View/Add Screen	MMR/Varicella – this combination vaccine has been moved from the drop-down vaccine list to the “shortcut” list with the other commonly given vaccines.
Vaccination Detail Screen	Lot number on a vaccination record can now be edited. After the last upgrade, you were not able to go back to an existing record and edit the lot number. This now works properly and can be edited by any user from the IRMS that entered the dose.
Vaccination Forecast	<p>Hib forecast – Combination of HepB/Hib was not recognized as a Hib vaccine and caused Hib to be incorrectly forecast. This has been fixed and forecast is now correct when this combo vaccine is entered.</p> <p>Hepatitis A – Red X was not appearing on doses given too early, although forecast was correct in recognizing that the early dose was invalid. The Red X now appears and the Invalid Dose Reason appears on the Vaccination Detail Screen.</p> <p>Please note the Forecast for the following vaccines will not be turned on until the State is able to supply them:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - HPV - Rotavirus - 2nd dose of Varicella for children under 13. <p>However, you may still enter doses given, and the Forecast will be triggered once it is turned on.</p>
