ENHANCEMENTS & BUG FIXES
Release Notes for Version 4.6.2 – April 17, 2009**

<p>NEW FORM AVAILABLE! New Certificate of Immunization Status</p>	<p>Under Reports: State Reports – Patient Specific: The School Certificate form has been replaced with the most current Washington State Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form used for school and child care entry. As with the previous form, the new certificate is produced in PDF format with all appropriate fields populated from the data in the registry.</p>
<p>NEW FEATURE! Immunization Detail Record - Dose Volume Added</p>	<p>Under Reports: State Reports – Patient Specific: The Immunization Detail Record Report has been enhanced and now includes a column for “dose volume” – if the dosage volume has been entered on the Vaccination Detail screen, it will now appear on this report. The Immunization Detail Record now has the ability to display and print out all the elements required by the VFC program for documentation of an immunization event.</p>
<p>NEW FEATURE! Enhancement to Aggregate Contraindication Report</p>	<p>Under Reports: State Reports - Other: The Aggregate Contraindications Report has been enhanced to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Present results by Vaccine Family rather than individual antigen. ➤ Add a column to display a count of contraindications that are recorded as “permanent” for each vaccine family.
<p>UPDATE - To Vaccine Abbreviations</p>	<p>Abbreviations for several vaccines have been updated to reflect their appearance on ACIP schedule:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ MCV4- changed to MCV (for Meningococcal Conjugate) ➤ MPSV4 – changed to MPSV (for Meningococcal Polysaccharide) ➤ PCV7 – changed to PCV (for Pneumococcal Conjugate) ➤ PPV23 – changed to PPV (for Pneumococcal Polysaccharide)
<p>IMPROVEMENT – Confidential Vaccine Default on Patient Records</p>	<p>Under Reports: Patient Record: The selection screen now defaults to “Do Not Include Confidential Vaccines.” If you want to include confidential vaccines on the print-out, you will need to select the radio button for “Include Confidential Vaccines”. (Note: this is a feature that was requested by clinics that provide services to consenting minors, such as Family Planning Clinics who administer HPV. It is dependent on selecting “confidential – yes” on the Vaccination Detail screen for a specific vaccine given.)</p>
<p>IMPROVEMENT- “PRINT PAGE” Function On Vaccination View/Add Screen</p>	<p>Previously, if you were on the Vaccination View/Add screen and clicked on the print page link near the top of the screen, the page briefly flashed in front of your eyes and then brought up a “Print Box”. Now, you will see the words view print page in the same location. When you click on the link, you will be able to view the page at your leisure. To print, you will now have to use your printer icon in your web browser toolbar or use the standard “File” function to get to your printer options, just as you do for other web documents.</p>

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<p>IMPROVEMENT – Vaccination Data Quality Reports</p>	<p>Under Reports: Report Module: Quality The Vaccination Data Quality Reports will now include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Pediarix given to persons over age of 7 years for the DTaP portion. ➤ Influenza, 6-35 months, given to persons over 35 months of age ➤ Multiple doses for single dose series ➤ Tdap given to persons younger than 10 years of age.
<p>IMPROVEMENT - CoCASA Export Function</p>	<p>The ability to access the CASA Export feature is now a permission that must be granted to individual users through the Web User Maintenance screen. All existing users have ALREADY had their accounts updated to include CASA Export. Any users who want this permission removed – to simplify the menu, for example - should contact their system administrator or the CHILD Profile Help Desk. In the future, new users wanting access to CoCASA export will need to have it added as a permission.</p>
<p>IMPROVEMENT – Lot Recall Report</p>	<p>Under Reports: Report Module – Lot Recall Report To compromise a specific vaccine lot, the drop-down list of reasons now includes only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Administered after Expiration Date ➤ Stored at Unacceptable Temperatures ➤ Vaccine Lot Recalled <p>Other inappropriate reasons have now been deleted from the drop-down.</p>
<p>IMPROVEMENT – Screening Questionnaire and Consent Reports</p>	<p>Under Reports: State Reports - Patient Specific: The Vaccination Screening Questionnaire and the Immunization Record Consent have been changed to allow only IRMS Client users the ability to edit the configurable text box for the consent portion. The consent message is now set at the IRMS level, not at the user level as previously. Facility clients will be able to see the message but not edit it.</p>
<p>FIXES TO FORECAST BUGS</p>	<p>A number of vaccine forecast bugs are fixed in this release, including changes to the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Rotavirus and the 8 month maximum ➤ Pediarix and compromised vaccine and the Hep B component. ➤ Influenza and the previous year dose correctly counted. ➤ TwinRix # 3 dose forecasting correctly now ➤ HIB forecast for #2 forecasting correctly now. ➤ Compromised Vaccine forecasting now will accept a vaccine given immediately or prior to the recommended date as valid. <p>If you have questions about any of these changes, please contact the CHILD Profile Help Desk.</p>
<p>HELPFUL HINT ON PATIENT SEARCH PAGE</p>	<p>Patient Search Page now has a tip for searching: When searching by First and Last Name, you may use the wildcard character % to replace multiple characters and _ to replace a single character.</p>
