 ENHANCEMENTS & BUG FIXES  
 Release Notes for Version 5.12.2 – April 14, 2012**

	AREA OF CHANGE	DESCRIPTION
1	<b>APPEARANCE</b>	<p>Changed the color scheme of the application and increased the usable width of each screen to increase the amount of information that can be displayed across each page.</p> <p>Added a “Message of the Day” on the login screen which displays at the top of the login page.</p>
2	<b>NOMENCLATURE CHANGE</b>	<p>Changed all instances of the word “Gender” to “Sex”, the more appropriate term, throughout the application.</p>
3	<b>PATIENT SEARCH/ADD SCREEN</b>	<p>Improved search queries to support searching by alias even when alias has been added by a user from a different medical organization.</p>
4	<b>PATIENT DEMOGRAPHIC SCREEN</b>	<p>Resolved an issue where patient address or phone was being required when the patient was being set inactive. You may now inactivate and save a patient record without filling in the address or phone fields.</p>
5	<b>REPORT MODULE: VACCINATION TOTALS REPORT</b>	<p>Added parameters to the “Vaccination Totals Report” to limit by patient birth date, gender, and age.</p>
6	<b>REPORT MODULE: PATIENT REPORTS &amp; STATE REPORTS</b>	<p>Corrected the issue where the “Patient Record – All Recorded Immunizations (Option 2)” will no longer display Tdap twice – under both the DTaP family &amp; the Tdap family. This correction also applies to the State Reports – Immunization Record Consent and Immunization Detail Record Reports.</p>
7	<b>LOT NUMBERS</b>	<p>Modified the Add Lot Number page to NOT have the radio button for publicly supplied default to “yes.” Users now have to select the “yes” or “no” button. If no option is selected on adding a new lot number, the user will be prompted with a box reminding them to select an option.</p>
8	<b>LOT NUMBERS: RECONCILIATION</b>	<p>Fixed the intermittent problem where the publicly supplied field was being incorrectly updated when updates were made to a lot using the Reconciliation screen.</p>

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<b>9</b>	<b>STATE REPORTS: LOT NUMBER SUMMARY REPORT</b>	<p>Fixed an issue where Lot Number Summary Report was not calculating correctly when the subtraction reason was “Administered chose not to be in the registry.”</p> <p>Improved formatting of this report. Removed sub-total column, modified columns order, abbreviated column headers, added column headings on each page when printing and added vertical gridlines.</p>

**Vaccine Ordering and Management for Providers**

	AREA OF CHANGE	DESCRIPTION
<b>1</b>	<b>DATA QUALITY CHECKS</b>	To make entry errors more visible, when an invalid character is entered in a vaccine ordering field, instead of the error message being in red text at the top of the screen, a pop-up box will appear.
<b>2</b>	<b>NEW EXCEPTON MESSAGE</b>	To make changes in shipping details more visible to approvers, any change to the Contact Name, Delivery Days and Times, and Shipping Instructions will receive an exception message box. An Exception Description must be selected to submit the order.
<b>3</b>	<b>NEW MENU ITEM TO MODIFY ORDER SET</b>	A new menu item for vaccine selection displays under the Create/View Orders menu. When the vaccine selection option is activated on April 23, 2012, providers will use this option to complete their vaccine selections and update their order sets. A training video to help providers complete the vaccine selection process using the IIS is available at <a href="http://jitt-wa.stchome.com/">http://jitt-wa.stchome.com/</a>
<b>4</b>	<b>SAVED ORDERS</b>	Fixed an intermittent problem with providers not being able to open Saved orders.
<b>5</b>	<b>RECEIVING ORDERS</b>	Fixed a problem with importing the McKesson shipping file. When providers receive their orders in the IIS the manufacturer, lot number, expiration date, and tracking number will now be pre-populated.

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**Vaccine Ordering and Management for Local Approvers**

<b>1</b>	<b>APPROVE ORDERS:  SORT ORDER</b>	The sort order for vaccine orders on the Approve Order screen has changed. Orders are now sorted by PIN then by Order Date.
<b>2</b>	<b>APPROVE ORDERS:  NEW DATA FIELDS</b>	Additional information displays on the Approve Order details screen including provider Contact Name, Address, Delivery Hours, and Exception descriptions.
<b>3</b>	<b>LOCAL APPROVER</b>	Added functionality to capture the Local Approver name for all orders that pass through the local approver queue (even if the order is approved without being opened). This change allows us to identify orders that bypass the local approver and go directly to the state.
