SUBJECT: **EXPIRATION OF PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR 20-62
REGARDING STATUTORY AND REGULATORY PROVISION FOR
CCRSS.**

PURPOSE: To inform CCRSS staff that Proclamation 20-62 expired August 7, 2020, which waived and suspended a portion of RCW 71A.12.250(2) and effected and waived a portion of WAC 388-101D-0475.

BACKGROUND:

- On July 8, 2020, Governor Inslee issued proclamation 20-62, Department of Social and Health Services, Developmental Disabilities Administration-Assessment and Reviews.
- Proclamation 20-62 waived the Community Protection Program Services **ninety day timeframe** for completing a review by the treatment team to assess each participant's (client's) progress, evaluate use of less restrictive measures, and make changes in the participant's program as necessary.
- The waived statutory requirement effected and waived the timeframe in WAC 388-101D-0475, Community Protection -Treatment team meetings, "The community protection service provider must participate in treatment team meetings **quarterly or more frequently as needed.**"

WHAT'S NEW, CHANGED, OR CLARIFIED: Proclamation 20-62 expired August 7, 2020, and was not extended.

ACTION: **Staff will:**
Be aware that Proclamation 20-62 expired, and during July 8, 2020 through August 7, 2020, the ninety day timeframe in RCW 71A.12.250(2) and WAC 388-101D-0475 were waived.
