The purpose of this document is to assist Private Duty Nurses (T1000 & 99600), who are social services medical providers, successfully bill using the ProviderOne medical billing screens.

The social service authorization list page **does not** include the modifier(s) or unit rate that corresponds to the Private Duty Nurse's license. When claiming, you must add a modifier(s) from the chart below into the Basic Line Information section of the claim and use the corresponding unit rate to calculate your "submitted charges).

- The agency pays for private duty nursing services per quarter-hour unit. 1 unit = 15 minutes.
- You must claim by date of service, the date the service was provided. You **cannot** use a date range for billing.
- The agency does not pay for the second client premium or overtime for clients age 18 and older.
- **Paid holidays are limited to:** New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Presidents' Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veterans Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day.
